
Accessible Interfaces for Medical Instrumentation: Draft Guidelines and Future Directions

Invitation to Submit Commentary

All Workshop participants are invited to submit commentary related to the Workshop that may be published in the upcoming book entitled *Accessibility and Usability Considerations for Medical Instrumentation*, to be published by CRC Press in 2006.

Please follow these guidelines for submitting commentary:

- Each participant is limited to one commentary.
 - Your commentary must include a title, preferably in the form of a statement or a question.
 - It must be 200 to 400 words long. It may include one figure. It may include several references, which don't count towards the word limit.
 - The content must be of a substantial nature. Opinions are encouraged, but should be expressed in a professional manner.
 - If possible, try to frame your commentary so that it fits with one of the following topic areas, which we tentatively plan to use for clustering contributions:
 - Specifics of emerging trends and their potential for impact on future interfaces
 - Terminology and conceptual frameworks
 - Targeted recommendations related to future standards & guideline development activities
 - Targeted recommendations to specific entities (e.g., a specific industry, RERC-AMI, FDA, NIDRR)
 - Your commentary must be submitted by October 31 to jack.winters@mu.edu; we will return decisions by November 7.
 - If accepted, the author must sign a CRC Press release form to allow us to publish it. The commentary collection will also be e-mailed to all participants, and may be disseminated by the RERC-AMI through its web site as part of its Workshop report.
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
